# Global Food Safety Curricula Initiative

## A Global Response to a Global Issue

Food Safety is a global public health priority. The Global Food Safety Curricula Initiative (GFSCI) adds the power of education to ensuring food safety from farm to table by linking institutions training food safety professionals around the world through a global core curriculum.

## A Global Process

Through the GFSCI process, core competencies of food safety undergraduate and graduate curricula will be developed, food safety programs around the world will incorporate them into their programmes for approval, and a Master's-Level Curricula and related delivery process will be developed and implemented.

## Global Collaboration

Led by IUFoST, scientists and industry experts are assessing the core competencies needed with partners across academia, industry and government. Institutions and individuals from around the world are participating in surveys to benchmark the status of food safety programs.
